[SheldonWordNerd:](#) @CollegeBoundNet "Personal reasons" generally meant "homesick" #collegebound

[GinaLaGuardia:](#) Q5 I'd agree with @SuzanneShaffer. Many transfers mean simply a shift in pursuit/intention/"fit." #CollegeBound

[CollegeBoundNet:](#) @SheldonWordNerd I knew a girl who left because a relationship went

awry. I still think about it to this day. #collegebound

[CollegeSurfing:](#) @SheldonWordNerd Sometimes finances come into play... students can better afford commuting from home. #collegebound

[GinaLaGuardia:](#) @SheldonWordNerd Oh, I hear ya. I do need a few more workday hours in today, though.... #CollegeBound
